

## Renhold's local environment: what do we value; what do we want?

We live in a great community surrounded by valuable countryside, but it is an area facing increased pressure for development. For that reason, we have commissioned *Bedfordshire Rural Communities Charity* to engage and consult with you, our residents, to produce a *Parish-wide Green Infrastructure Plan* which will help inform the emerging Neighbourhood Plan.

The first step is a *Green Infrastructure Survey* which *is an assessment to identify natural or semi-natural areas that are important to us in our Parish now and in the future.* It gives us all an opportunity to explain what aspects of the local environment we value, our aspirations and our views on how our local environment should be protected and enhanced. It will also help to prioritise actions for improvements to Renhold's network of public access, biodiversity, heritage and landscape.

This process would normally start with a face-to-face community workshop, but because of Covid-19 social distancing restrictions, that will not be possible. Instead, this public consultation will commence with a *Zoom presentation from Bedfordshire Rural Communities Charity at 7.00pm on Thursday February 4<sup>th</sup>*.

Following this presentation, you will be able to fill in an **online or a paper survey** in your own time over the subsequent couple of weeks. Maps and guidance notes will be available to view on a dedicated BedsRCC webpage here (link here).

If you would like to join the Zoom presentation to hear more about the Renhold Parish Green Infrastructure Plan, please e-mail TBC. You will be sent a link about a week beforehand to join the live presentation and to access the online survey.

If you cannot take part in the Zoom presentation or the online survey, you will still be able to have your say. Just return your completed paper questionnaire to one of the collection boxes located around the Parish\*\* and we will collect them from there.

The results will be drawn together to create a draft *Green Infrastructure map of community aspirations*. There will be a *further consultation in early 2021* before the draft map is finalised.
