PLANNED FOOTWAY WORKS FOR RAVENSDEN ROAD, RENHOLD

We are writing to you to let you know that roadworks are due to start soon on the above road as part of Bedford Borough Council's highway works programme.

The works will consist of:

- Footway Resurfacing works.
- Associated civils works.
- Kerb replacements.

These works are currently planned to start on 26th February 2024 and are programmed to take 10 working days to complete. As such the works will be undertaken in phases and with the appropriate Traffic Management measures as listed below:

Phase	Works/Traffic Management	Start Dates	End Date	Working Times
Phase 1 – Various kerb replacements and other civils works	Two way traffic lights and footway closures	26 th February 2024	1 st March 2024	0900-1530
Phase 2 – Resurfacing	Two way traffic lights and footway closures	4 th March 2024	8 th March 2024	0900-1530

Signs will be put up at the ends of the site which will provide the most up to date information if the programme changes.

Please note the following during the works:

- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- Please be respectful of the workforce and, if you are permitted to drive through the road closure please keep speeds down to a minimum to protect the safety of the workforce.
- All site vehicles are fitted with reversing beepers and flashing lights so please be careful when approaching the site.

- Resurfacing operations are noisy and we apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause you. The works have been programmed in co-ordination with our Streetworks teams to ensure that they are carried out at the best times to reduce traffic disruption.
- Before we close the road, we may carry out some minor works that may mean that some areas are coned off or temporary traffic lights may be used.
